**First Reading: Isaiah: 58: 7-10**

This reading is a vigorous exhortation from prophet Isaiah to lead lives of active charity and generosity. He promises that the Lord will be our dawn, our rear guard and our light, if we share our bread, shelter the homeless and clothe the naked.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2: 1-5**

Paul tells the Corinthians that he and they must not rely on the so-called wisdom of secular teaching and philosophy but on the power of the Spirit.

**Gospel: Matthew 5: 13-16**

Jesus reminds the disciples and all Christians that they carry special responsibilities to be the salt of the earth. They must not hide their light but show their goodness to all.
